

How to Plan a Delhi to Kashmir Trip in Winter: Your Ultimate Guide

 - **Tip:** This is a more time-consuming option, and the road journey from Jammu to Srinagar can be challenging in winter due to snow, especially around the Jawahar Tunnel.
- By Road (For the Adventurous): A road trip from Delhi to Srinagar (about 812 km) is for the truly adventurous, but itâ??s not recommended in the heart of winter (January and February) unless you are an experienced driver with a vehicle equipped for snow. The journey can take 18-20 hours or more, and parts of the NH44 highway can be closed due to snowfall.
 - **Tip:** If you do plan a road trip, stay updated on road conditions and consider hiring a local driver who is familiar with the terrain.

2. Crafting Your Perfect Itinerary (5 to 7 Days)

A well-planned itinerary is crucial to make the most of your winter trip. A 5- to 7-day trip is ideal for covering the main highlights.

- Day 1: Arrival in Srinagar & Dal Lake: Arrive at Srinagar airport. Check into your hotel or a traditional houseboat on Dal Lake. Enjoy the breathtaking sight of the lake, which might be partially or fully frozen. In the evening, take a serene Shikara ride, a truly iconic Kashmiri experience.

- Day 3: Day Trip to Gulmarg: Drive to Gulmarg, the â?? Meadow of Flowers, â? which transforms into a skiing and snowboarding paradise in winter. The journey takes about 2-3 hours.
- Day 4: Gulmarg Adventure & Return to Srinagar: Take the famous Gondola ride, one of the
 highest cable cars in the world. The ride has two phases: Phase 1 to Kongdori Station and Phase
 2 to Apharwat Peak. Enjoy skiing, snowboarding, or simply playing in the snow. Return to
 Srinagar in the evening.
- Day 5: Excursion to Pahalgam: Drive to Pahalgam, a scenic town known as the â?? Valley of Shepherds.â?• The drive (about 2-3 hours) is beautiful, with views of saffron fields and quaint villages. In winter, Pahalgam is quieter but no less stunning.
- Day 6: Pahalgam Exploration & Back to Srinagar: Explore the snow-covered landscapes of Aru Valley, Betaab Valley, and Chandanwari. Pony rides are a popular way to get around. Note that some routes might be closed depending on the snowfall. Return to Srinagar for your final night.
- Day 7: Departure from Srinagar: Enjoy one last cup of Kashmiri Kahwa before heading to the airport for your flight back to Delhi, with a camera full of memories.

3. Packing Essentials: Staying Warm and Safe

Winter in Kashmir is characterized by freezing temperatures, often dropping below zero. Packing the right clothes is essential.

- Layers are Key: Dress in multiple layers. Start with thermal innerwear, add a fleece or woolen sweater, and finish with a heavy, waterproof, and windproof jacket.
- Footwear: Sturdy, waterproof boots with a good grip are a non-negotiable item.

- Cash is King: While major hotels and restaurants accept cards, many local shops and smaller establishments operate on a cash-only basis. Carry sufficient cash, as ATMs can sometimes be out of service, especially in remote areas.
